



WVHRA Scholarship Information

The Wabash Valley Human Resources Association (WVHRA) is an organization created by and for Human Resources (HR) professionals in the Wabash Valley. We provide educational and professional development opportunities for our core members and prepare current practitioners for future positions with greater levels of responsibility in the Wabash Valley HR community. We are a local chapter of the Society for Human Resources Management (SHRM), the foremost expert, convener and thought leader on issues impacting today's evolving workplaces and creates better workplaces where employers and employees thrive together.

WVHRA Scholarships are awarded based upon the financial need of the student and the applicant's successful fulfillment of the identified scholarship criteria. Requirements for eligibility and consideration are as follows:

1. Applicants must have completed or be currently enrolled in at least 12 undergraduate or graduate credits in an HR program of study at Indiana State University, St. Mary-of-the-Woods College, or Ivy Tech Community College.
2. Application: Submit the completed WVHRA Scholarship Application.
3. Transcript: Submit current semester transcript of college coursework (copy accepted) reflecting a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher.
4. References: Submit two references using only the WVHRA Reference Form, at least one reference may be academic.
5. Personal Statement: Submit a 300-500 word personal statement describing how receiving the WVHRA scholarship will assist in reaching your college and career goals.

Graduate Scholarship recipients will receive \$1,500.00 and Undergraduate Scholarship recipients will receive \$1,000.00. Scholarships may be used to defray the cost of spring semester books, tuition, or room and board.

The scholarship recipients will be chosen by the WVHRA Scholarship Committee. Applicants are reviewed on an individual basis by the committee. To be considered for either scholarship, you must complete the application and submit the required supporting materials on or before the application deadline. Late applications will not be given consideration.
